

Health and safety declaration for visitors to Abbeyfield houses



Abbeyfield seeks to ensure the health and safety of all our residents, staff, visitors, contractors, committee members and volunteers.

It is currently mandatory for every visitor to complete the following statement of declaration before entering any Abbeyfield house or construction site.

I confirm:

- I and everyone in my household am/are currently free of any Covid-19 symptoms (no cough, fever, shortness of breath, sore throat, sneezing and runny nose, temporary loss of smell).
- I am not waiting for a Covid-19 test result, nor have I been directed by Public Health or the Ministry of Health (MOH) to take a test or self-isolate.
- In the last 14 days I have not been to any of the locations of interest identified on the Ministry of Health website (health.govt.nz).
- In the last 14 days I have not been to, or returned from, anywhere in New Zealand with active Covid-19 cases.

In the last 14 days, I have not been in contact with any person:

- With Covid-19;
- In self-isolation;
- Who has been contact traced for Covid-19 and is waiting for a test or has been tested for Covid-19 and is waiting for the results; or
- Working at the border (airport/seaport) or in a quarantine/isolation facility;
- Who has been to, or returned from, anywhere in New Zealand with active Covid-19 cases.

In the last 28 days I have not been overseas or been in contact with any person who has been overseas.

Note: If you cannot confirm all of the above statements, please do not visit this house, for the safety of residents, staff, and everyone visiting the house.
