AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND After a huge task of pulling all the necessary information together our bid for half the cost of the build for the house has been submitted to the Affordable Housing Fund. Our thanks to Isabel lead of the strategic team and Susan Executive Officer, Abbeyfield NZ for all the work they undertook to complete the necessary documentation. Now we wait. Notification will be in October.

ACHIEVABLE - We need to raise the shortfall! Can you help?

Success with the Affordable Housing Fund would mean that we would have a small funding shortfall to find so we can begin to build. We are currently continuing our fundraising and the Strategic Team are approaching corporates and philanthropists who may be willing to donate towards the build.

Examples of this is the wonderful lady who makes regular monthly automatic payments, the anonymous person who has set up a bequest with Acorn and this year Acorn through the bequest has donated \$961.45.
