Working is progressing well towards starting the build. If you've passed the section recently you will see our new sign that says building will start in the New Year. However, since being notified the house was going to start in January, it's all changed, and we are looking forward the builders being on site in November. Which is so exciting.

We are already starting to think of timelines for furnishing the house, selecting tenants and housekeepers among other things we need to put in place next year ready for residents to move into the house.

The trees, all but one, have been removed, we tried really hard to save as many as possible however with the size of the house it just wasn't possible. However, we will replace and are working on a landscape plan. The cut down trees were cut into rounds and sold for firewood.

We have had several meetings with our Project Manager as we get our head around the build, and it has been informative about what we need to do.

We are also thinking about the interior of the house, colour schemes and furniture and are exploring options particularly where we it would be possible to get discounted prices to help save money.

We started in February with a shortfall of \$280,000. However, with lots of hard work and the generosity of the community we now have less than \$200,000 to go. Really this isn't a worry as we are very confident that we will have raised this before the end of the build.
